

Cotemar completes the Comprehensive Tank and Wellheads Interconnection Program for the Wells at the Quesqui and Tecominoacán Oilfields

Mexico City, Mexico.- Cotemar has announced that on March 24, it completed the work on the Comprehensive Interconnection Program of Tank FA-100B located in Quesqui 1, the Wellheads of the Quesqui 2, 3, and 4 wells, and the Installation of the Sour Gas and Vent Lines for the Tecominoacán Separation Battery.

The activities performed included the manufacturing and installation of the mix inlet line, the oil outlet line, the gas outlet line, and the vent line to interconnect the FA-100B three-phase separator tank.

"The work for the Comprehensive Interconnection Program was divided into strategic priorities, allowing us to complete it a few days before the agreed date with an outstanding performance.
